Access Class 2011 European Championships on Lake Garda

Circolo Vela Gargnano, situated in Bogliaco on the western shore of picturesque Lake Garda in Italy, will host the 2011 European Access Class Championships from Tuesday 24 to Sunday 29 May next year.

Competition will include Access 2.3 single-person, Access 303 single and two-person, Liberty and SKUD 18. Single-person and two-person divisions will be grouped into two fleets with each sailing two races per day over 4 days. It is expected the event will attract more than 40 entries from 6 nations.

The club has an experienced group of race management volunteers supported by professional staff who have conducted a large number of national and world championships. The club is famous for hosting the annual Centomiglia regatta.

There are a range of low and medium cost accommodation facilities in Bogliaco, the village in which CVG is situated. Several of these have accessible rooms. There is also a camping park within 1km of the club. A short distance away, in Gargnano, Toscolano and Maderno, there are a wider range of accommodation types and more accessible rooms. The regatta dates avoid the peak holiday season to ensure accommodation is more available and less expensive.
