The Access Dinghy Association have planned another exciting series of races in 2007 for all you Access Dinghy sailors who like to travel to other clubs .

In the Travelers Trophy (TT) we have a total of **nine events** of which **four will count**, this will keep the contest achievable to those who cannot make it to them all.

This year the Buddy Assist Class will be integrated with the main 303 class, racing for the same trophies on equal terms

The new class of sailing called, Buddy Assist, that was introduced last year proved a success and will be fully integrated into the main 303 fleet throughout all the Access racing events in 2007. To remind you, the "Buddy Assist" class In this class is sailed in an an Access 303W and must have two sailors, one must have special needs/disability and the other may be a sailor without special needs/disability. In this class the boat may be helmed partially or fully by either sailor.

This "Buddy Assist" class is designed to make Access Racing accessible to people with special needs/disabilities that prevent them from helming the boat throughout the race without assistance.

Please help us build on the success of last season by supporting this "Buddy Assist" element of the Access 303 class and enable a whole new group of sailors to experience the excitement and camaraderie of Access racing.

Why not ask your Helpers and Club sailors to bring a boat to one of our events (the Access 303 wide fits easily onto the roof bars of a car or most small dinghy trailers) and give one or more (different special needs/disabled members can sail in the 3/4 races) of your special needs/disabled members the thrilling experience of sail racing. I can promise you it is most rewarding and great fun.

Regional Championships to sail for in 2007

Again this year we are organising a "Access Dinghy Southern Championship" and a "Access Dinghy Northern Championship".

Each will have a **303 class** (Please Note that this year this 303 class will include 303s boats ballasted to 90KG and 303 Buddy Assist class, all sailing on equal terms for the same trophies), a **2.3 class**, and a **Liberty class**. These events will be Northern/Southern Championships as well as TTs. Both events are open to all Access sailors. Both are one day events.

The "Southern Championship" will be run at the Frensham Pond TT.

and

The " Northern Championships" will be run at the Swalkestone TT
The " Northern Championships" will be run at the Swalkestone TT

It is hoped that the Access sailors in the south who are not able to get to the Traveller series will join us at Frensham and compete with our Traveller fleet for the Southern championships and that those in a similar circumstances in the north will join us at Swalkestone for the Northern Championships. It is hoped that the Access sailors in the south who are not able to get to the Traveller series will join us at Frensham and compete with our Traveller fleet for the Southern championships and that those in a similar circumstances in the north will join us at Swalkestone for the Northern Championships.

In Addition to these the fleet will again sail for the Duke of Devonshire Trophy at the Carsington TT

Points are awarded as follows:

- One point for 1st place, two points for 2nd place etc.
- DNF stands did not finish and denotes Sailors who start the race but do not finish for any reason including retirement. These will be awarded points equal to one more than the number of boats entered in their class on the day.
- NCS stands for sailed but did not cross the start line. These will be awarded points equal to two more than the number of boats entered in their class on the day.
- DNS stands for did not start and denotes Sailors who have started at least one race in the series of TT events but not sailed at this particular event. These will be awarded one point for each boat in their category (i.e. 2.3 or 303)in the TT series up to and

including the Tideway event plus 1 extra point. **Note: DNS points will be calculated after the Tideway event as it is only then that we know the total number of boats that started up to then.**

● Each Sailors best four results count. other results are discarded / excluded.

● If a tie occurs in the overall results for the TT series, events in which all the tied competitors met will be considered. The result of the most recent of these will be used to break the tie.

If the tied competitors have not met in any TT event, their respective next best TT result, a fifth event, will be added in an attempt to break the tie. If they are still tied, the result of the most recent event of their respective best 5, in which they all competed, is used to break the tie. If each of them participated in less than five events, and are tied, the overall trophy will be shared

Access Travellers Trophy 2007

Ben Ainslie Team Trophy

Results below

For results to qualify for inclusion towards the team trophy the Helm must have sailed at least four events in the series.

The formula for calculating points for the team trophy award

This year there is a change in the method of calculating the points in the Team Trophy. In order to make the team's contribution more representative of their overall ability and effort we will be taking into account their average performance by totaling each sailors total points in their best 4 races in the series and dividing this by the total number of boats in their class. we will use this figure to calculate the team event results. The team with the lowest total points for their three qualifying sailors (i.e. those who have completed at least 4 races in the series) will win. The formular will be:

The total points for the sailor in their four qualifying races. **divided by** the total number of boats in their class in the series **(up to and including the Tideway event) multiplied by 10.**

The make up of a Team

The team will be a clubs best three qualifying sailors/boats in the overall series.

Or

if your club does not have three qualifying sailors we are this year allowing sailors from different clubs to form a team together in order to take part in the Team Trophy until such time as you can gather sufficient numbers in your own club. You can negotiate amongst themselves as to how you combine, providing that

1. the combination lasts the whole year and that
2. you declare the combination before the forth race of this season (this time has been set for this year only because of the late time in announcing it to competitors.) and that
3. there be a maximum of two clubs that could combine.

A team therefore is made up of each Clubs or declared teams best three sailors/boats overall series results,

calculated according to the Team method laid out above, across the following classes:

Tie Break

In the event of two clubs having the same number of points the club with the best fourth members result will win. This will be applied through all the clubs qualifying sailors and results until the tie is broken. If after this a tie still exists the club with the most first places will win. This will be applied through all the clubs qualifying sailors and results until the tie is broken. If after all this has been applied a tie still exists the above tie breaking rules will be applied to the results of the Clubs non-qualifying sailors until the tie is broken.
